

### **Date of issue- 30.03.2026**

All Helmets permitted for 2026 MCUI tarmac events Must comply with the following standards and specification:

- Must be manufactured to the following standards:
- ECE 22.05
- ECE 22.06
- Snell M2020
- JIS T8133
- FRHPhe-01
- FRHPhe-02
- Must be within 5 years of date of manufacture
- Must be manufactured from fiberglass/Kevlar/carbon composite, Thermoplastic helmets are not acceptable
- Must have DD-ring type strap buckle.
- Internal visors are prohibited

### **Date of issue- 12.03.2026**

Superstock motorcycles over 1000cc and up to 1100cc 4-cylinder, must be equipped with the MCRCB/MSVR specified ECU and dash, see MCRCB/MSV authorised parts list.

Full details of the motorcycle model and the MCRCB/MSVR prescribed technical interventions will be published by Bulletin.

This ECU option and specification may be utilised for all machine models in the 1000/1200 4 cylinder class only.

The Aprilia 1100 RSV4 can only be equipped as per BSB pathway controlled ECU and firmware. No Stock or 'Kit' ECU can be used at the North West 200 .

### **Date of issue- 26.01.2026**

**CONCUSSION.** Once concussion is confirmed the rider is **immediately excluded** and **must not** compete further in the event (including subsequent days) and their competition licence suspended for the minimum period's specified below:

**An adult is considered to be 18 years and over.**

- The mandatory minimum period of suspension is 10 days from diagnosis, including the day of the incident.
- Permitted to return to sport on the 11th day.

**A child is considered to be 17 years and younger.**

The mandatory minimum period of suspension is 20 days from diagnosis, including the day of the incident.

- Permitted to return to sport on the 21 st day.

**Gradual Return to Riding/Racing Program (GRTR)**

No competitor diagnosed with concussion may return to racing without clearance by a medical practitioner AFTER completing a Return-to-Sport program.

**Insurance requirements for onboard cameras** - Minimum cover of £10M Public Liability insurance competitors are required to hold for "Onboard Camera".
